



North Shore Christian School Scholarship Program

Guidelines

North Shore Christian School offers partial and full scholarships based on household income and need. Any child is eligible to apply if they meet the financial qualifications. Please read our Scholarship Policy on page 2 to see qualifications.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- Seeking families who possess a vested interest in their child's educational program.
- Applicants and their families must adhere to North Shore Christian School's guidelines, procedures, and belief policies. Please refer to the NSCS handbook.
- NSCS awards scholarships based on household income. Proof of income must be provided (i.e. previous calendar year tax return plus two month's most recent pay-stubs).
- Scholarship funds are to be directly paid to North Shore Christian School and not to the student.
- Application should be filled out completely (including essay) and then submitted by email to nscsmanson@gmail.com.
- Parents and students will be asked to attend an in-person conference prior to awarding the scholarship.
- The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by a committee consisting of North Shore Christian School board members.



Scholarship Policy

Income breakdown:

1. Household Income \leq \$50,000:
 - Scholarship: 100% (Full tuition coverage)
2. Household Income \$51-56k:
 - Scholarship: 75% (Tuition reduced to \$112.50 per month)
3. Household Income \$57,000- \$62,000:
 - Scholarship: ** 50% (Tuition reduced to \$225 per month)
4. Household Income \$63,000 - \$68k:
 - Scholarship: 25% (Tuition reduced to \$337.50 per month)
5. Household Income $>$ \$69k:
 - Scholarship: No scholarship (Full tuition of \$450 per month)

Adjustments for families supporting more than 1 dependent:

Deduct \$5,000 from income for each dependent, over one dependent.

For example: if your household income is \$57,000, and you have two children, your household income would decrease by \$5,000 and be \$52,000. Income would be deducted by \$10,000 if you have three children...
