



2022 North Shore Christian School Scholarship Program

Guidelines

North Shore Christian School announces the 2022 Scholarship Program to be awarded to two students. Under this program there are two (2) \$3,500 scholarships that will be awarded to an incoming North Shore Christian School student plus the cost of the child's curriculum program. Any child entering the first or second grade is eligible to apply if they meet the financial qualifications.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- Seeking families who possess a vested interest in their child's educational program.
- Applicants and their families must adhere to North Shore Christian School's guidelines, procedures, and belief policies. Please refer to the NSCS handbook.
- Applicants must have a combined household income of \$50,000 or less to apply for this scholarship. Proof of income must be provided (i.e. previous calendar year tax return plus one months most recent pay-stubs)
- Scholarship funds will be paid **in September 2022 for the first year's full tuition-** to be directly paid to North Shore Christian School and not to the student.
- Application should be filled out completely (including essay) and then submitted by email to nscsmanson@gmail.com with a deadline of **June 1st by 4:00 p.m.** (Handwritten applications will be accepted and may be delivered in person to North Shore Bible Church.)
- Late applications will not be accepted.
- Parents and students will be asked to attend an in-person conference prior to awarding the scholarship.
- The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by a committee consisting of North Shore Christian School board members. The scholarship will be awarded June 10th, 2022.
